Black Isle was started by David Gladwin in 1998. An unemployed beer lover, he set out to make world class beer using barley and hops grown on organic farms as nature intended, without the use of destructive chemicals.

Today they can brew up to 10,000 litres a day packaged in bottles, casks and kegs. They ship beer all over Scotland, the UK and around the world from Sweden to Japan.



Red Kite - 568ml. (Draught) £5.00

A soaring amber ale with a perfect balance of citrus and malt



Porter - 330ml £4.75

A dark, ruby malty beer with an aroma of late summer fruit and light treacle. One glass is better than toucans!



Scotch Ale - 330ml £4.75

A liquid fruit cake with a malty foundation and a rich spice finish, this will fill your palate and astound you for minutes as you unlock the multi-layers of flavour.



Schiehallion - Craft Lager - 568ml (Draught)

The perfectly-paired combination of wheat malt and lager malt is our secret sauce for this 'Champagne of Lagers'. A lingering, fresh grapefruity finish from whole, pressed hop cones tops it off. £5.00



Drygate - BearFace Lager - 500ml £5.50

Heavy on the hops, light on the tongue. Clean & crisp citrus hints.



Brewdog Punk IPA - 330ml £4.75

Layered with new world hops to create an explosion of tropical fruit and an all-out riot of grapefruit, pineapple and lychee before a spiky bitter finish



Brewdog 5AM Saint, Red Ale - 330ml £4.75

Notes of lychee, orange peel, apricot, and pine accompanied by a smooth malty backbone. A good balancing bitterness makes this amber ale a very enjoyable drink



Isle of Arran Blonde - 500ml £5.50

Light toasted malts with a taste of citrus hops. The sharpness is tampered down by a creamy smoothness. Medium to light, pleasant, more sweet than a bitter, with a hint of golden syrup.

Goldeneye Pale Ale - 330ml £4.75

Fresh toast, marmalade and peach coming from a complex blend of lightly roasted malts and new world hops.



Yellowhammer IPA - 330ml £4.75

Dry, flinty, thirst quencher, with a grapefruit and toffee aroma.



Best of the Rest

Bitter & Twisted - Golden Ale - 330ml £4.75

Bitter & Twisted was allegedly named after the brewer's wife. A refreshingly lively blonde beer with a tingly, lemony finish, it goes down a whole lot better than his little joke did.



Orkney Northen Light - Pale Ale - 500ml £5.50

A pale straw colour. Refreshing citrus flavours dominate the palate with hints of Brioche and fresh bread, giving way to a clean refreshing hoppy aftertaste.



Orkney Gold, Gold Ale - 500ml £5.50

Refreshingly crisp with zesty sweet lemon mandarin and apricot on the palate balanced by a juicy malt background



Orkney Dark Island - 500ml £5.50

balanced by flavours of dark Chocolate, dried fruit, figs and nuts from the combination of roasted malts and rich hops. this beer has twice won CAMRA's Champion Beer of Scotland.
